Serra da Estrela: places with history

DAY 1 Departure from Porto and arrival in Viseu or welcome in Viseu

Departure from place and time to be agreed – Porto or Viseu. Hotel check-in. Dinner.

DAY 2 Viseu > Linhares da Beira > Valhelhas (almoço) > Centum Cellas, Belmonte > Viseu

We leave Viseu and head to the foothills of Serra da Estrela to meet the warming and historical village of Linhares da Beira. We visit the imposing castle, keeper of the territory since King Sancho I. We walk around its historical streets, we have a glimpse at Casa do Judeu and the ancient Hospice and we hear the legend of D. Lôpa, who walked the streets collecting souls for the Devil. We cross Serra da Estrela through its scenic route and admire breathtaking landscapes. We have lunch in the typical village of Valhelhas. Then, we go to Colmeal da Torre, Belmonte, to visit Centum Cellas ruins, one of the most awe-inspiring and enigmatic roman sites. Return to Viseu. Dinner.

DAY 3 Historic city centre of Viseu > Lunch > Departure

Our weekend ends with a visit to the historic centre of Viseu, a city with 2500 years. We begin our trip in front of the Cathedral of Santa Maria. In between streets and narrow alleys we tell you about the ancient *vissaiegi*, fearless people, Jews and artists. Viseu is the home of mythical warriors as Viriato, eloquent kings as D. Duarte and famous painters as Vasco Fernandes. Hotel check-out. Lunch at typical restaurant. Departure.
