## The noble vineyards of Dão

The region of Dão is Portugal's second oldest demarcated wine region, and so we invite you to discover some of its hidden treasures. Among the amazing vineyards, we show you archaeological findings, we reveal secrets, we tell you stories and taste distinguished nectars.

We visit the noble village of Santar and its eclectic manor houses. We get to know vineyards and find out new flavours. We walk through 2.500 years of history at the "Antiqua e Nobilissima" city of Viseu and get dazzled by an old Mutatio – a roman station for changing horses.

### DAY 1 Departure from Porto and arrival in Viseu or welcome in Viseu

Departure from place and time to be agreed – Porto or Viseu. Hotel check-in. Dinner.

### DIA 2 Viseu > Mangualde > Santar > Viseu

We leave Viseu towards Mangualde. We go back to the 1<sup>st</sup> century and explore the roman ruins of the Mutatio of Raposeira, a changing horse station with an inn for roman travellers to spend the night. From here, we head to Santar, council of Nelas. We visit the village, the Church of Misericórdia and some of its greatest manor houses. At Paço dos Cunhas, we savour a meal prepared with refinement, harmonized with Casa de Santar's most distinguished wines. At Casa de Santar, we stroll through vines and gardens. We admire the fountain of running water inside the 17<sup>th</sup> century kitchen and the Coaches Hall. Return to Viseu. Dinner.

### DAY 3 Historic city centre of Viseu > Lunch > Departure

Our weekend ends with a visit to the historic centre of Viseu, a city with 2500 years. We begin our trip in front of the Cathedral of Santa Maria. In between streets and narrow alleys we tell you about the ancient *vissaiegi*, fearless people, Jews and artists. Viseu is the home of mythical warriors as Viriato, eloquent kings as D. Duarte and famous painters as Vasco Fernandes. Hotel check-out. Lunch at typical restaurant. Departure.
